בְּאִמִּירַת תְּהִלִּים (פז. ז) אֹמְרִים כָּל מַעֲנֵי הַכֹּף בְּקִמְץ, בְּסֹדֶר בְּרַכַּת הַמְּזֹן – הַכֹּף בְּחֹלָם.

In the phrase kol mayanai bach (Tehillim 87:7), [the word כל may be vocalized in either of two ways]. When one is reading Tehillim, this word should be pronounced as vocalized with a kamatz; when it appears in [the readings that precede] the Grace after Meals,¹ it should be pronounced as vocalized with a cholam.²
